





#### 1. Purpose

This policy describes our principles and intentions, the requirements we place on our supplychain in relation to the delivery of fresh wood based fiber materials and the framework and tools we use in the process to ensure compliance with this policy.

#### 2. Sco

This policy is applicable to all wholly owned businesses in the Essity Group.

It is intended to be used as a reference for Essity's business partners and affiliates, and these are expected to adopt and apply equivalent standards to those reflected in this policy.

#### 3. Description

Easity is a global user of both fresh and recycled wood based fiber materials and is committed to soutching fresh wood based fiber originating from responsibilly managed forests. This policy encompasses all procurement of fresh wood based fiber materials within lastity, is susty supports, encourages and prioritizes best practices in Sustainable Forest Management and wood fiber traceability in its supply chain of fresh wood based fiber materials. Easity will continue to use a significant percentage of recycled paper in its products, which play an important role in a circular economy and rescurce efficiency, and will continue to expine the use of alternative fibers. The domands on the supply chain for these two categories of fibers are covered by other documents.

#### 3.1 Principles

With this fresh wood based liber sourcing policy and framework, Eastly aims to play an active part in preventing deferentation and ferest degradation, prometring and increasing the use of responsibly managed and certified ferests, and increasing the proportion of certified fibers used in Eastly products. Eastly also aims to be a driving force for positive social and economic development for people and communities affected by frorests operations in its supply chain.

#### 3.2. Description of policy

The following five categories are stipulated as unacceptable sources for the origin of fresh wood based fibers used in Essity's supply chain!:

- 1. Illegally harvested wood.
- 2. Wood harvested in violation of traditional or human rights.
- Wood from forests in which high conservation values are threatened by forest management activities.
- 4. Wood from forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use.
- 5. Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.



As defined by UN GA RESULTING and UN FAD Points 1-5 are defined as referenced in FSC\* (forest Stawardship Council) CW standard 40 005.
